The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated
01.10.2021, under Sections 307, 341, 325, 323, 379-B, 506 and 34 IPC,
registered at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the
complainant have pointed out that in the present case, the complainant-
Karamjeet Singh has not been examined as yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some
time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at
this stage, with liberty to file fresh petition after the

complainant/Karamjeet Singh in the present case is examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage, with liberty to file fresh petition after the complainant/Karamjeet Singh is examined.

It is made clear that the second petition for regular bail, if any filed by the petitioner, would be considered independently on its merits, in accordance with law.
