This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 21 dated 4.2.2022, under Sections 406, 420, 201, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The bone of contention in the FIR was an agreement to sell.

On 8.4.2022, the matter was referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre and arrest of the petitioner was stayed.

Report of the Mediator has been received annexing the settlement agreement as the parties have settled their dispute.

In view of the above, the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to her joining investigation within two weeks. In the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. She is directed to join the investigation as and when called for. She shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.

In case of failure of petitioner to join the investigation or change in circumstances, the State would be at liberty to file an application

for re-calling of this order.
