Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short “the Code”) seeking quashing of FIR No.271 dated 13.09.2019, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Upon instructions received from SI, Balkar Singh, State counsel submits that the impugned FIR has been quashed by this Court vide order dated 01.09.2021 passed in CRM-M-21667-2021 in exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 of the Code on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties. She submits that the petition has become infructuous.
