[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.02.2019, in CWP No.5409 of 2019 in case titled as 'IdeaForge Technology Pvt. Ltd. versus Union of India and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP No.5409 of 2019 on 28.02.2019 and directing the writ petition to be listed for hearing along with CWP No.5183 of 2019 on 13.03.2019, it was ordered that till the next date of listing, the tender be not finalized with any bidder.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner refers to order dated 30.08.2022, as per which, CWP No.5409 of 2019 has been dismissed as having been rendered infructuous on account of the tender in question having been scrapped.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the
aforementioned position, he does not press the instant petition.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of
learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not
calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of
Courts Act, 1971.
