The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.278 dated 21.10.2021(Annexure P-1) registered under Section 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, at Police Station Sector-39, Chandigarh.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.04.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Major Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 01.04.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
