Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is entitled for the higher pay scale but the same is not being granted to him as recommendation of 5th Pay Commission, as admissible to pensioners, is not being implemented qua the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for the revision of his pension w.e.f. 01.01.2006 along with arrears.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 10.01.2020 (Annexure P-2) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in view the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 10.01.2020 (Annexure P-2) , the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the legal notice dated 10.01.2020 (Annexure P-2) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
