By way of the present appeal, the appellant has challenged the order dated 02.01.2019 passed by learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur, exercising the powers of Guardian Judge under the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 (for short, 'the Act of 1890'), whereby the petition under Section 25 of the Act of 1890 filed by appellant Nihal Singh for entrustment of the custody of minor son, namely, Ekamjot Singh from the custody of respondent Harmesh Kaur, was dismissed.

Both the parties are present in Court.

A sum of Rs.25,000/- has been paid by the appellant to the respondent towards the litigation expenses in compliance of the order dated 20.04.2022.

As per the report of the Mediator, Mr. Sachin Jain, Advocate, dated 25.05.2022, the parties have settled their dispute by way of an amicable settlement and the settlement/agreement dated 25.05.2022 has been reduced into writing.

The afore-said settlement/agreement be made part of the record.

In the aforesaid settlement/agreement, it has been agreed between the parties that the custody of minor child namely Ekamjot Singh will remain with the mother, i.e the respondent, for all times to come.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties amicably by way of settlement/agreement dated 25.05.2022 arrived at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the present appeal.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
