[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 19.01.2022, in CWP No.976 of 2022 in case titled as '**Harbans Kaur versus State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.976 of 2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide representation dated 14.12.2021 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the relief claimed, to release the same to the petitioner without any delay.

[3] At the outset, learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy

of communication dated 15.06.2022 from the Punjab National Bank, Tarn Taran to General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Patti, that arrears of pension amounting to Rs.5,30,940/- have been credited in bank account bearing No. 0454000108955119 of the petitioner on the orders of the District Treasury Office, Tarn Taran. The aforementioned communication is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
