The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for seeking quashing of impugned order dated 13.06.2000 passed by respondent No.2 vide which the ration depot of the petitioner has been cancelled and for quashing of order dated 23.05.2000 vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner had been rejected.

There has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing. It is evident that the ration depot in question had been allotted to the petitioner in the year 1975 and the writ petition has been pending since the year 2000. Invariably, the petitioner would be in his early 70's. It seems that the petitioner would not have any subsisting grievance in the present petition. The case is thus dismissed for want of prosecution.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in the event any cause of action still survives.
