This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the official respondents to delete the vehicle of the petitioner from online portal maintained by Mining and Geology Department and Transport Department, Haryana to enable him to get E-Rawaana for the minerals loaded from the different crushers and also to get renewal certificate w.r.t. the fitness of the vehicle and permit.

2. On 31.03.2022, notice of motion was issued. Today, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not yet approached the department. In case, the petitioner files appropriate application praying for the said relief, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.

3. Finding it to be a fair stand taken by the State, the present petition is disposed off. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to approach respondent No.2-The Director General, Mining and Geology Department, Haryana with an appropriate application within a period of two weeks from today.

4. In case appropriate application is received by respondent No.2, he/she shall decide the same in accordance with law within two weeks thereafter. Needless to say in case the petitioner is found entitled for the relief prayed, the same shall be granted. In case, it is found that the petitioner is not entitled for the relief, his representation shall be adjudicated by passing a speaking order. Needful be done within the time period as stipulated hereinabove.

5. Disposed off as such.
