(1). Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2, dated 28.11.2019, in CWP No.34658 of 2019.

(2). Notice has not yet been issued in the instant petition.

(3) At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the order, Annexure P/2, dated 28.11.2019 has been complied with as representation dated 14.10.2019 (AnnexureP-3) has been decided by the respondents, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn.
