As per custody certificate, filed in Court today, the petitioner is on interim bail on account of COVID-19 pandemic, as per the instructions of High Powered Committee.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that two of the co-accused, i.e. Harcharan Singh and Ranjodh Singh, husband and brother of the present petitioner, respectively, have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court, vide orders dated 14.12.2021 passed in CRM-M Nos. 11940 and 32974 of 2021.

Learned counsel further submits that the investigation qua the petitioner is already complete and after presentation of *challan*, the charges have been framed, therefore, the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court as and when required and will apply for grant of fresh bail in view of the changed circumstances.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner moves a fresh regular bail application before the trial Court, the same will be decided in view of the changed circumstances, without being prejudiced by the earlier orders.
