Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., *inter alia* for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct fair investigation into complaint dated 22.02.2021 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Crime Against Women & Children, Amritsar City, has been on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, wherein, it has been submitted as under:-

“7. That it is humbly submitted that keeping in view the totality of the facts and submissions made hereinabove, it is evident that a thorough probe has been conducted by SHO PS Women-1, Amritsar into representations given against respondent No.4 and his family members by the petitioner. The

allegation being leveled therein by the petitioner with regard to committing rape with her on the allurements of marriage by the respondent No.4 was not proved and the petitioner could not produce any solid evidence with regard to the allegation of misappropriation of her gold ornaments and Rs.2.50 lakhs. Therefore, the applications given by the petitioner have been consigned to record record. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.”

In view of the above, no direction is required to be passed.

Petition is dismissed.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail remedy available to her, in accordance with law.
