Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No.19 dated 13.10.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana Rural (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

After having argued for sometime, counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not press the petition. He, however, submits that petitioners No.1 and 2, who are the sister-in-law and her husband and petitioner No.3, who is 71 year old, is the father-in-law of the complainant-respondent No.2, may be exempted from personal appearance before the Trial Court.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Petition is disposed of with a direction that personal appearance

of the petitioners shall remain exempted before the Trial Court subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That the counsel for the petitioners will keep on appearing before the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- (ii) That the counsel for the petitioners will give undertaking before the Court about the instructions of the petitioners to cross-examine the witnesses in their absence.
- (iii) That the petitioners will not dispute the identity of the witnesses examined in their absence.
- (iv) That the petitioners will give undertaking in the Court that they will put in appearance on every date as and when required by the Court.
