This petition was filed seeking quashing of order dated 7th April, 2018, whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person in case FIR No. 240, dated 3rd November, 2017, under Sections 409, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 10, 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.
