The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the respondents, especially respondent No.2, to conduct prompt, proper and fair investigation in case FIR No.703 dated 27.11.2019 under Section 3 of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Section 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Sonipat City, District Sonipat, with a further prayer to quash the impugned cancellation report dated 31.08.2020.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has pointed out that even though the cancellation report dated 31.08.2020 has been prepared, yet the same has not been presented before the Illaqa Magistrate and the same has thus, prejudiced the petitioner as he is unable to take recourse to the remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition has already been handed over to the learned State counsel. He

reiterates the above contentions of the petitioner and assures that appropriate action shall be taken expeditiously.

With the consent of parties, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 to submit the cancellation report, if any, before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of four weeks from today.
