Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the affidavit filed on behalf of the State shows that land comprised in Khasra No. 97 is vacant and has been reserved for toilets. Thus, the garbage dump can be shifted to the said land. Refusal to do so is not justified.

A perusal of the status report shows that a meeting of the Gram Sabha had been called wherein it had been resolved that the garbage dump be not shifted to Khasra No. 97 as adequate space was not available for dumping and that the land reserved for garbage dump is suitable.

One person can not be permitted to go against the combined will of the people of the village.

The writ petition is accordingly, dismissed.
