Petitioner is seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.498 dated 3.4.2019, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram.

The petitioner-Pardeep Yogi along with Laxmi filed a protection petition in the Court and submitted the rent deed showing themselves to be resident of Gurugram. While dealing with the petition, it was found that the rent deed was a forged document and FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 9.2.2022. No further recovery is to be made. Allegations are based upon documentary evidence.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer and submits that the petitioner is involved in one more FIR.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the nature of allegations against the petitioner, though investigation is complete conclusion of trial is likely to take time, case is primarily based upon documentary evidence, bail is granted to the petitioner on furnishing surety

bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
