ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to reinstate him as 'Safai Karamchari'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been terminated from service on account of registration of a criminal case against him. The allegations against the petitioner were false and his services have been erroneously terminated.

Heard.

The petitioner was stated to be working as a 'Safai Karamchari' on daily wages. An FIR was registered against him on the allegations that he had misbehaved with two ladies, who were working as Clerk and Beldar. He was convicted at the conclusion of the trial. In appeal, the Appellate Court, while maintaining the conviction, instead of sentencing him has ordered his release on probation for a period of six months. In view of the factum of the petitioner being a daily wager and his conviction in a criminal

case, I do not find the order of termination of the petitioner to be suffering from any illegality so as to warrant interference of this Court while exercising the writ jurisdiction.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
