Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.81 dated 13.04.2019, registered for offences under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short “IPC”), however, later on Section 376, IPC and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 were added, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 15.02.2020, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Mr. Raghav Soni, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant-respondent No.2 and has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.

Faced with the observations made by the Supreme Court in ***The State of Madhya Pradesh Versus Laxmi Narayan and others 2019 (5) SCC 688***, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
