Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.32 dated 04.03.2022 registered under Sections 452, 323, 295, 427, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 307 and 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur, who apprehend their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 01.04.2022, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are husband and wife and the role only attributed to them of carrying of bricks but no injury has been attributed to them. He further submits that no untoward act has been attributed to any of the petitioners in the FIR.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amardeep Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab and has not controvert the afore-said fact. He however, submits that the petitioners have actively participated in the incident in connivance with other accused-persons.

Mr. Vipin Mahajan, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed his

memo of appearance, the same is taken on record. He also undertakes to file power of attorney on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 13th May, 2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated themselves in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Yusuf Masih, states that indeed the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.04.2022 is made absolute.
