Through this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.97 dated 05.11.2020, registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 22 and 29 (added later on) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the present case, co-accused, namely, Ravi Kumar and Jasjot Kaur were apprehended at the spot alongwith the contraband; that during investigation, the co-accused disclosed the name of Javed to the effect that he had handed over the recovered contraband to them; that during investigation, the aforesaid co-accused had disclosed the mobile number as 76689-52862 stating that the said mobile number belonged to Javed, but as per the customer acquisition form, the said mobile number is in the name of the petitioner, who stands released on anticipatory bail; that the petitioner was never identified by the co-accused; that he has nothing to do with the alleged offences, and that charges are yet to be framed.

Keeping in view the fact that charges are yet to be framed, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is

disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the points before the trial Court at the time of framing of charge(s).
