This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 441, dated 26.12.2019, registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307/506/34/120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that firstly the occurrence is one where nobody received any injuries, the allegation being that shots were fired at a particular premises and further, he submits that his name has allegedly been disclosed in police custody by one Dilpreet Singh.

A reply to the petition has been filed by the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, dated 09.11.2021, in which the details of 05 other criminal cases registered against the petitioner, in Punjab, have been given.

The petitioner is stated to have been in custody since September 2020, i.e. for about 01 year and 04 months, with the trial still to effectively commence even as per instructions of learned State counsel (though in the affidavit of the ACP dated 09.11.2021, it is stated that the matter was still under investigation).

Looking at the aforesaid facts, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
