FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

During the course of hearing arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions has made statement withdrawing the present petition. However, a fervent prayer has been put forth by learned counsel citing orders of this Court dated 24.06.2021 whereby directions were issued to the trial Court to expedite the matter and dispose it off preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of copy of the order. However, as has been brought to the notice of this Court that out of total 18 prosecution witnesses only 15 have been examined.

Be that as it may, the present petition is disposed off with directions to the trial Court to ensure that the remaining witnesses, if

any, be examined within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, else this Court shall view the matter strictly keeping in view the inordinate delay of more than four years that has come about in disposal of the matter and the petitioner accused is languishing behind bars since then.
