[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 05.02.2020 in CWP No. 3097 of 2020 in case titled as Dharam Pal Singh vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No. 3097 of 2020 was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 herein to consider and decide show cause notice dated 12.03.2018 in accordance with law after taking into account reply dated 23.05.2018 filed by the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned DAG has placed on record copy of order dated 06.07.2022 deciding the show cause notice and releasing the payment to the petitioner as per entitlement determined therein.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 06.07.2022, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge the same to

reply dated 23.05.2018 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] The same is not opposed to by the learned DAG.

[6] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
