Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.196 dated 05.07.2017 under Sections 406, 498-A and 120-B of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar, Annexure P-1, alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
