1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 in RFA-4-2016, in case titled as Mehar Singh (deceased) through his L.Rs. and others vs. Punjab State and others.

2. Notice has not yet been issued in the instant case. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to filing of reply, the respondents have deposited the total amount as per entitlement in the bank account of the petitioners, in terms of order Annexure P/1, in RFA-4-2016 and that in the circumstances the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
