Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.462 dated 5.9.2021 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 427 and 506 IPC, Section 3 of SC & ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Section 285 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act was deleted), registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 01.04.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from HC Anil Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated

01.04.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 01.04.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
