This petition has been filed against assessment. When we pointed to the learned counsel that this is appealable order he stated that in a case of the previous year, this Court had directed the Appellate Authority to decide the claim but the same has not been decided which the assessing officer is continuing to pass orders. In our considered opinion, this may not be a sufficient reason to clothe this Court with extraordinary jurisdiction.

Learned counsel then stated that during this interregnum, the limitation for filing the appeal has expired.

On the asking of the Court, Ms.Sudeepti Sharma, learned Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and very fairly states that in case the petitioners now file an appeal within 10 days along with deposit of 25% of the demand raised, the appeal shall be decided on merits.
