The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 24 dated 02.02.2020, registered under Sections 458, 323, 324, 326, 379, 427, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 17.03.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Randhir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

Considering the fact that the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail on 17.03.2020 and since then a period of almost two years has lapsed and the petitioner has not misused the same, the present petition

is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 17.03.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
