Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and Annexure P-32 to P-37 are permitted to be taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was granted the selection grade in the pay scale of Rs.4100-5300/- in the year 1995 but the same was withdrawn in the year 2001 on the ground that there are two separate cadres one mechanical cadre and other civil cadre, whereas the competent Court of law has already held that the cadre of mechanical engineer and civil engineer in the respondent-Department is one. Learned

counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the said pronouncement and

repeated request of the petitioner for restoring benefit of selection grade of Rs.4100-5300/- from the date it was earlier granted, matter is being kept pending by the respondents-State and that too without any valid reason. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that vide Annexure P-28 even the Engineer in Chief of the respondent-Department has written on 24.11.2020 to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, Public Health Engineering Department, Chandigarh that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of benefit of selection grade pay of Rs.4100-5300/- with the further revision but no outcome of the said recommendation has come so far from the Government.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.1 to pass appropriate orders on the recommendation of the Engineer in Chief dated 24.11.2020 (Annexure P-28).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, no order has been passed on the recommendation Annexure P-28 by respondent No.1 so far, appropriate order on the said recommendation dated 24.11.2020 (Annexure P-28) will be passed by respondent No. 1 within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will also be released to him within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
