ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Seeking fair and impartial investigation, the petitioner has come up before this Court under Section 482 CrPC.

Since counsel for the petitioner did not appear on any date, this Court had appointed Mr. Gagandeep Singh Virk, Advocate as a legal aid counsel on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned legal aid counsel submitted that he had interacted with the petitioner and he got instructions that the petitioner is not satisfied with the investigation.

At this stage, learned State counsel submits that the investigation is complete and the investigator has filed an untraced report before the concerned Court.

Given above, appropriate remedy for the complainant (petitioner herein) is to file a protest petition before the concerned Court. Consequently, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to file a protest petition. It is clarified that before accepting the untraced report, the concerned Illaqa Magistrate will give the petitioner appropriate time to

present his contentions.

Learned legal aid counsel shall be entitled for grant of remuneration as per the rules.
