Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, inter alia, seeking direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to decide the pending appeal dated 30.01.2019 (P-5) filed by the petitioner challenging the order dated 25.01.2019, passed by respondent No. 3 (P-4).

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that they have no difficulty in deciding the appeal within four weeks.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with the observation that respondent No. 2-Financial Commissioner,

Department of Revenue, Mini Secretariat, Punjab, shall consider and decide the aforesaid appeal dated 30.01.2019 (P-5), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
