MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.150 dated 15.09.2012 under Sections 279 and 304-A Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, Punjab, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police, pursuant to the order dated 06.03.2019 (Annexure P-5), whereby he was declared as proclaimed offender.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail by trial Court, but when he absented in January, 2019, the said concession was cancelled and arrest warrants were issued against him to secure his presence. Concededly, the petitioner was well aware of the pendency of the trial proceedings against him, who abruptly disengaged himself

without any sufficient reason and was subsequently declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 06.03.2019, therefore, in view of the decision of this Court dated 09.08.2021 delivered in CRM-M-21334-2020 (*Akhtar Vs. State of Haryana and others*), this petition is not maintainable.

Resultantly, petition fails and is dismissed.
