ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to take action against the accused persons on the basis of the applications and complaints (P-1, P-2, P-4 & P-5) submitted by the petitioner and also to issue directions to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from the hands of accused persons.

Learned State counsel submits that since respondent No.6 is currently out of India, as such the prayer regarding protection has become infructuous.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 21.03.2018 (P-4) within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Punjab Police Head Quarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to decide the representation (P-4) by passing a speaking and reasoned order within ***thirty working days*** from today.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, liberty is reserved to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
