Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the order passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.2866 of 2014, titled 'Karanvir Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 30.09.2016, the petitioner became entitled for the relief of the grade pay of Rs.4800/- and by a notification dated 04.7.2019, the State of Punjab had generalized the said judgment to implement qua all who are covered by the same but even as of now, the petitioner has not been granted the benefit, for which he is entitled for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance, as has been raised in the present writ petition, has also been raised in his representation dated 27.10.2021 (Annexure P-5), which is still

pending consideration with the respondents authorities and the petitioner will be satisfied in case direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation dated 27.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kanisth Ganeriwala, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 27.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the present petition or in the legal notice, the respondent No.4 is directed to decide the representation dated 27.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefits, the same be also extended to him within a period of next four weeks.
