Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CRM-M-51024 of 2021, titled as “Biirmati Vs. State of Haryana and others”, dated 06.12.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The petition was disposed of with the following directions:-

“The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action against the Private respondents who gave beatings to the petitioner and insulted her who is a widow lady and further for directing the official respondents for taking action on the applications dated 30.07.2021 and dated 13.08.2021 (Annexures P-1 and P-2).

Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the application/representation dated 13.08.2021 (Annexures

P-2) in accordance with law within a period of one month from today.”

In reply, learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Deputy Superintendent of Police, Safidon, submits that the order passed by this Court has been complied with and the representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing a speaking order.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.
