Prayer in this petition is for quashing the impugned order dated 23.03.2022 (Annexure P-12), passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Moga, vide which in revision No. 21 of 2022 titled as ***Balvir Singh and another vs. State of Punjab and others***, an *ex-parte* stay has been granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in a revision filed by respondent Nos. 2 and 3, the Additional Sessions Judge, Moga has granted an *ex-parte* stay and, therefore, the receiver is not in a position to take the possession of the property.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab and Mr. Rajesh Bhatheja, Advocate, who are present in Court, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and respondent Nos. 2 and 3, respectively.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 2 and 3 has stated at bar that there is no intention to delay the proceedings and this petition may be disposed of with a direction to the revisional Court to decide the revision

expeditiously.

In view of the same, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the present petition has been filed challenging an *ex-parte* order of stay granted by the revisional Court, it will be appropriate to direct the revisional Court to decide the main revision petition within a period of one month in view of the urgent nature of the dispute *inter se* parties.

Ordered accordingly.

The revisional Court shall decide the main revision petition on or before 02.05.2022.
