Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0033 dated 26.02.2022 registered under Sections 18/25/29 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of ASI Tarsem Singh, he got a secret information that Gursahib Singh @ Sahba i.e. the petitioner, is bringing Opium from outside and if a barrier is laid, he can be apprehended. Thereafter, a car was stopped on suspicion and 02 person namely Harminder Singh and Partap Singh were arrested and recovery of 3.20 Kgs. of Opium was effected from them in the presence of a Gazetted Officer. It is further submitted that the petitioner was not arrested at the spot.

Counsel for the State has however, argued that the petitioner is involved in one more FIR under the NDPS Act, in which he was convicted for a period of 01 year and one case registered under

Section 279-B IPC is also pending against the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner was named in the FIR as a suspect. Lastly, it is submitted that as per the call details, the petitioner was in touch with the co-accused at the time when they were arrested.

In view of the above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
