The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of direction to the respondents to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.0781 dated 24.09.2015 under Sections 302, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal (Annexure P-1) to some independent agency such as Crime Branch/CBI or to a SIT.

The Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the Status report dated 14.5.2018 as per which a Polygraph test was held on Poonam wife of Rambir, Mamta wife of Ajay, Deepak son of Rambir, Cheeku son of Pappu and Deepak son of Sumesh. All of them were said to be suspects. However, as per the Polygraph report (Annexure R-1) attached with the Status report all of them have been found to be innocent.

The Counsel for the State has also referred to the said report to

argue that the matter was investigated twice and an untrace report has been prepared on 30.09.2017. The reply has set out the detail how the investigation was carried out right from the very inception. He submits that the same shall be submitted to the Court within a period of six weeks from today.

I have heard the counsel for the parties and also been through threadbare their respective pleadings.

There is nothing to suggest that the investigation has not been carried out in a fair manner so as to warrant an investigation by the CBI. However, it is expected that if any evidence comes to light in this matter at any stage, the investigating agency will proceed to further investigate the same.
