The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her minor son at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a teacher by profession whereas her husband-respondent No.4 is working in a bank; that respondent No.5 is the sister-in-law of the petitioner and respondents No.6 to 8 are the brothers of the petitioner; that at one stage, two-year-old child of the petitioner was taken away by respondents No.4 and 5; that by way of CRWP-7723-2021, the petitioner approached this Court for getting her son released from the forced confinement of respondents No.4 and 5, and that even respondents No.6 to 8 are giving regular threats to the petitioner, who may be protected from them as well.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The marriage of petitioner and respondent No.4 was solemnized on 23.02.2019 and one male child was born out of the said wedlock. There seems to be a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.4 and the real brothers of the petitioner i.e. respondents No.6 to 8 are even asking her to join the matrimonial home.

In view of the above, this Court finds out that no interference is called for in the present matter.

Dismissed.
