Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing DDR No.22 dated 19.11.2021 under Sections 326, 325, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran in FIR No.73 dated 14.11.2021 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 308, 325, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 01.04.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Tarsem Masih, DSP, Sub Division Valtaha Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran and on instructions from ASI Baljinder

Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 01.04.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 01.04.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
