Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case the petitioner, who has retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.12.2019, is not being paid her pensionary benefits, admissible to her including the leave encashment and gratuity.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before respondent No.4 vide representation dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage at this stage in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No. 4 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to decide the representation dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
