VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the impugned FIR No. 61 dated 30.01.2020 registered under Section 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the IPC (Annexure P-11) at Police Station, Sector-5, Panchkula along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in view of the reply filed by way of affidavit of Umed Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula on behalf of State of the Haryana, he does not wish to pursue the present petition and wants to withdraw the same.

Mr. K.D.S. Hooda, Advocate appears on behalf respondent No.2 and contends that the Police is in active connivance with the petitioner and that they have deliberately chosen to file an un-traced

report in order to extend undue benefit to the petitioner without taking into consideration the relevant documents furnished by the complainant and without looking into the veracity of the same. There is no occasion to submit an untrace report considering that the documentary evidence establishing fraud and forgery committed by the petitioner is duly submitted to the Investigating Agency.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition and noticing that the respondent No.2 has his remedies available in accordance with law, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the parties to take recourse to the remedies available to them in accordance with law.
