This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR no.75 dated 07..05.1994 registered under Section 304-A IPC at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom as well as quashing of order dated 30.05.1996 (Annexure P-2) vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana.

It has been pointed out to learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had earlier filed CRM-M-4575-2014 challenging the order dated 30.05.1996 vide which the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender and in the said petition, the following order was passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners on instructions, prays that this petition be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file a revision petition.

*Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
However, if the revision petition is filed within 15 days
from today, it shall be heard and disposed of on merits.”*

It has been pointed out that in the petition at page no.10, the petitioner has stated that he has not filed any earlier petition.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
