VIKAS BAHL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. For quashing of the FIR No. 20 dated 29.08.2018 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points that have been raised in the present petition before the trial Court at the appropriate stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is the resident of District Aligarh, U.P. whereas the FIR has been registered in the District SAS Nagar, Mohali and prays that thus, his personal appearance may kindly be exempted before the trial Court.

In view of the same, the personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner shall be represented through his counsel;*
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;*
- iii) shall not dispute his identity as accused;*
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence but in the presence of his counsel;*
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;*
- vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.*

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
