1. Prayer in the petition is fortaking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.01.2020, in CWP-1905-2020.

2. Learned Counsel contends that while issuing notice of motion in CWP-1905-2020, order of status quo was passed and that although the instant petition was filed on account of the failure of the respondent to do the needful, now the needful has been done in compliance of order Annexure P/1, therefore, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

3. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
