Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for quashing the action of the respondents in assessing the performance of the petitioner for the purpose of recording of ACRs for the period 2017-2018 by evaluating the primary class students under *Paro Punjab Parao Punjab* (PPPP) format.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 18.07.2018 (P-3), followed by Legal Notice dated 22.09.2019 (P-4), is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 & 5 to 7 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, Standing Counsel for respondent No.4- Punjab School Education Board and Ms. Amrita Singh, Advocate for respondent No.8-Union of India also accept notices and raise no objection.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the quarter concerned to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 18.07.2018 (P-3), followed by Legal Notice dated 22.09.2019 (P-4) by passing reasoned order as per law within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

If there is no legal impediment, petitioner be granted personal hearing also.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
