The petitioner has filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to protect his life and liberty, as respondent No.6 is threatening and pressurizing the petitioner to not to pursue his complaint against him for alleged injuries caused to the petitioner.

Learned counsel has argued that the private respondent No.6 had caused injuries to the petitioner and the relevant medical record is Annexure P-1. He submits that the petitioner had given a complaint to the police, whereupon no action has been taken so far. He submits that private respondent No.6 is pressurizing the petitioner to compromise the matter and in this regard, he has given a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran on 13.11.2021, but till date no action has been taken upon the same, therefore, he prays that appropriate directions be issued for registration of a case against respondent No.6.

After hearing the learned counsel and considering the nature of

injuries suffered by the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction, as he can avail alternative remedy in accordance with law.
