JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, with a prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

On 7.4.2021, notice of motion was issued in this case and the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, was directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner as set out in the petition.

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The reply has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagadhri, Yamuna Nagar by way of email which is taken on record since the matter is being taken up through video conference.

Learned State counsel while referring to the reply filed by the State has submitted that after receipt of the present petition, the petitioners were contacted and their statements were recorded. Petitioner No.1 has stated that she has solemnised marriage with petitioner No.2 Jugnu Kumar on 22.3.2021 and in the petition they had given the address of the sister of Jugnu Kumar at village Baloli and now they are residing in village Shadipur and have no threat to their lives from any person. It is further stated in the affidavit that the petitioners have no threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents. However, the petitioners will be provided necessary protection if they will approach the local police.

In view of the affidavit filed by the State, no further action is required to be called for in the present case.

Disposed of accordingly.
